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## Pre-Certified Nurse Assistant

The Nurse Assistant Training program is designed to qualify the student for the California state certification. Preparation includes classroom instruction and supervised clinical training within the guidelines set by the State Department of Public Health Services.

**Duration:** 50 Hrs. (Theory) & 100 Hrs. (Clinical)

## Medical Terminology:

This course helps the student to successfully build his vocabulary and understand medical terms through mastery of word roots, suffixes, prefixes, and combining forms. The student will learn to effectively use medical terminology as a tool for real work situations.

This course is not intended to be a substitute for any state, government, licensing, or educational requirements. The students will be awarded a certificate of completion from Monsbey College. This is a non-credit course, and is provided for your personal enrichment.

## Pharmacy Technician

This 3-5 month course is designed to prepare the participant for eligibility to become a Pharmacy Technician. In addition, participants will be qualified to apply for certification by the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) will meet the training requirements of the State Board of Pharmacy.

**Duration:** 180 Hrs. (Theory) & 120 Hrs. (coordinated externship)

## Home Health Aide

This 40 Hrs. program prepares the Certified Nursing Assistant to be a Home Health Aide.

The C.N.A.'s will acquire skills and knowledge necessary to provide services to residents in the home or residential care facilities.

Preparation includes classroom instruction and supervised clinical training approved by the State Department of Public Health.

**Duration:** 6 Days (40 Hrs.)

**Day Program:** (7:00 am – 3:30 pm)

**Fees:** \$100 registration (Non-Refundable) Plus \$450 (Reference Book and materials included)

## CPR and First Aid Courses

First aid, CPR, automated external defibrillation (AED) and other health and safety training are offered in collaboration with American Red Cross.

An American Red Cross certificate will be issued for successful candidates.

## Clinical Medical Assistant

This 2-5 month course is designed to prepare the participant for eligibility to become a Clinical Medical Assistant (CMA).

In addition, participants will be qualified to apply for certification by the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) and/or the California Medical Assistant Association (CMAA). Participants will receive a certificate of completion and be job-ready upon completion of the course. This program is offered in collaboration with Watsonville/Aptos Adult Education.

**Duration:** 130 Hrs. (Theory) & 160 Hrs. (coordinated externship)

## NCLEX Review
